

Privacy policy

For us, Stichting International Student Productions Enschede (Stichting InSPE, hereafter InSPE), to work properly as a foundation, we need to use some personal information from our participants and from people related to us in other ways. We find it important to handle this information with care. In line with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)/ Algemene Verordening Gegevensbescherming (AVG), we put up this document on how we handle personal information and what rights you have.

In the following overview, you can find the information we collect and use for the different purposes we fulfil as a foundation. Furthermore, the retention and person(s) who process this information are named.

The provision of personal information to third parties

InSPE gives personal information to third parties in order to fulfil their duties as a foundation. Unless mentioned otherwise, we are not obliged by law to inform you what information is given to other parties. We will always make sure personal information is handled with care and not used in any other way than agreed upon with the different parties.

Insight, correction and removal of personal information

You have the right to contact us with a request to see your personal information (unless we as a foundation are not obliged to give this in line with the GDPR). Furthermore, you have the right to correct, add, remove or shield personal information. If you have the wish to remove certain personal information, we will report the removal to all other parties who received the information concerned from us.

Protection of personal information

InSPE takes appropriate measures to ensure the security of your personal information. Only the essential people will have access to personal information and will handle them with care. The information will be shielded and protected and we will monitor the security of your information by changing passwords regularly and keeping an eye on the accessibility of personal information on the different platforms we store them.

Underage persons

If you wish to register as an underage person, you need to have explicit permission from your parent or guardian.

Cookies

A cookie is a small text file that is sent along with the pages of a website and is saved by the browser on your computer, tablet or mobile phone. We use cookies to offer a better, easier-to-use service when you visit our website. Cookies, for example, make sure that you stay logged in at a website or that your preferences, such as location and language, will be remembered. We also use cookies for analytics, i.e. to see which pages of our website and how often are visited.

Before cookies can be used, you need to agree with the website placing them. Your permission for cookies can be cancelled anytime by changing your browser settings. More information about the (de)activation and the removal of cookies can be found in the help-function of your browser.

Links to other websites

The parties that are linked to our website or have our permission to use your information will process the information as stated in their privacy policies. InSPE is in no way accountable for the way these instances store and secure their information. While choosing these parties, we make sure companies do not misuse personal information or sell information to other parties.
